COUNTY EXECUTIVE GANNON ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FOR PUBLIC ADMINISTRATOR POSITION

JEFFERSON COUNTY, MO – Jefferson County Executive Dennis Gannon is accepting letters or emails through 5 P.M., April 24, 2023, from individuals interested in filling the Public Administrator position vacancy. On April 7, 2023, Jefferson County Public Administrator, Steve Farmer announced that he would be retiring at the end of May 2023.

Per the County Charter, with the vacancy of any elected County Office position, the County Executive must appoint an individual to hold that office until the next general election. The appointee must be affiliated with the same registered political party as the person previously holding the position.

“We have full intentions of having an appointee ready to take office June 1, 2023, following Mr. Farmer’s last day,” said Gannon. “We thank Mr. Farmer for his years of elected service and wish him a happy retirement.”

To serve as Public Administrator, candidates must meet the following qualifications as outlined in the County Charter:

- Must be a Registered Voter in Jefferson County.
- Must be a resident of Jefferson County for at least 12 months.
- Must be at least 24 years of age.
- Must be a Citizen for at least twelve months.
