Jefferson County Department of Public Works provides Walk Bike Jefferson County Master Plan status update and upcoming fall community engagement opportunities

Hillsboro, MO (September 19, 2024) – The Jefferson County Department of Public Works, in partnership with local firms Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc. (CMT) and SWT Design, continues the process in creating the Walk Bike Jefferson County Master Plan. A draft network for walking and biking, as well as draft street design guidance, are being developed after completing a comprehensive existing conditions analysis and first round of community engagement. These elements will be combined to develop the draft plan document. The draft plan focuses on addressing safety, connectivity and comfortability of people walking and biking in Jefferson County, as well as a strategy for prioritizing improvements. Draft plan recommendations will continue to be shared throughout Fall 2024, with final plan submission for approval in early 2025.

Extensive public engagement continues to be a key element of the plan. Two community engagement opportunities are approaching this fall, where everyone is welcome and encouraged to provide feedback on the draft plan.

- A Public Open House to share the draft plan recommendations is scheduled for Thursday, October 24, from 3-6 PM, in the Assembly Room of the Jefferson County Administration Center, 729 Maple St, Hillsboro, MO 63050. Attendees will be able to view and provide feedback on the draft plan at this Open House.

Additionally, a pop-up demonstration will be simultaneously occurring outside the building on Maple Street, to help showcase and visualize what street improvement concepts are included in the plan to create safer spaces for walking and biking.

- A booth at the Apple Butter Festival in Kimmswick, MO, on Saturday, October 26, from 1-5 PM, will be staffed by the project team to provide the community and festival attendees an additional opportunity to view and provide feedback on the draft plan.
