Program Narrative

A. Description of the Issues-

Jefferson County, Missouri is a suburban county with six hundred sixty-four (664) square miles of land and water. The approximate population for the county is 224,000 with Ninety-six (96) percent being Non-Hispanic Caucasian, one (1) percent African American, and three (3) percent other races. Jefferson County Sheriff's Office is the primary law enforcement agency for Jefferson County and has one hundred seventy (170) sworn personnel. In 2022, Jefferson County Sheriff's Office responded to a total of 69,499 calls for service. This total includes all categories of calls from citizens as well as officer on-view incidents.

To comply with the 911 mandate for interoperability, our agency is requesting to purchase five (5) dual band vehicle mounted radios. Dual band radios would greatly aid the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office for interoperability needs with the multiple agency and jurisdictions that we aid. The radios are equipped with 800MHz and VHF radio bands that the officer can choose the appropriate band required. The radios hold a higher capacity of channels to accommodate communication with all public safety personnel. Other features of the radios include noise canceling microphone system and a large front display. In all, the dual band radios requested will give our officers' maximum functionality with the current and upcoming communications systems. This is an ongoing effort to replace older radios as needed and to outfit newly hired officers.

B. Project Design and Implementation-

The design and implementation of the project is straightforward. The equipment will be purchased and installed in a timely manner. All items will be requested for

purchase through Jefferson County Purchasing Department; once the items are approved for purchasing, the items are ordered through the respective companies. Once the items have been received, which typically takes one to two months depending on the company, installation of the items can begin. The Jefferson County Fleet Department installs all equipment into patrol vehicles, and this typically takes a couple months depending on their workload for all items to be installed on each vehicle. Because our agency currently has contracts with the specific companies, there is no bid process necessary for the purchase of the items. A bid process, at which time the public can comment, was previously completed to enter the contracts with the companies. Once all items are installed and in use, benefits will be able to be seen instantaneously.

Concerning the NIBRS requirement of the project, our agency utilizes the St. Louis County CARE Records Management System. The Computer Assisted Report Entry (CARE) records management system was developed in 1984 by the St. Louis County Police Department for the law enforcement community. As authorized in St. Louis County Ordinance No. 26,663, the Cooperative Application Services Agreement between REJIS Commission (REJIS) and St. Louis County, REJIS and the St. Louis County Police Department have partnered in the expansion of the CARE system. REJIS understands the nature of technological applications are mission critical and a robust, full-functional records management system is essential to police operations. Regional data sharing is at the core of REJIS, providing clients with technology to fight crime; more data means more crime solvability. CARE equips officers with information that pertains to people, vehicles, addresses, and more, through investigative searches. The objectives of using the CARE system are to increase officer safety and provide analytical

tools to analyze emerging crime trends, properly allocate resources and view current activity. CARE operates through the CJIS secure REJIS network, with the latest technology allowing all report data to be maintained in a reliable and secure site within REJIS. The records management system is continually being enhanced, many of which are the results of users submitting suggestions for CARE innovations.

IBR/MIBRS/NIBRS data fields and reporting requirements are currently incorporated into the CARE RMS. The next system modification phases will include IBR data validation checks and submissions compliancy. CARE is NIBRS compliant as of 2019 and we are requesting a waiver of the NIBRS set aside.

C. Capabilities and Competencies-

Jefferson County Sheriff's Office currently has in house training concerning dual band radios and we conduct trainings as needed for new officers receiving equipment to ensure that the officer knows the functions and maintenance of the items they are receiving. Due to the increased training, officers are more productive in their duties on the job because they know the ins and outs of their devices. As an officer becomes more accustomed to their new equipment, their work and performance will produce more favorable results for everyone involved. Some of the increased productivity includes faster investigation time, faster report approval time, and more in-depth investigations. Officers with the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office are and will be fully capable to fulfill their job responsibilities with the added technology provided through the solicitation.

D. Data Collection-

The Jefferson County Sheriff's Office currently compiles statistics for the various departments in our agency. Jefferson County 911 Dispatch provides our agency with the

statistics for calls of service that our agency was dispatched. Platoons where officers are assigned compile data of the number of calls for service that each officer is assigned. Each division also keeps track of the inventory for the officers assigned to their platoon and the Jefferson County Auditor's Office also does yearly physical inventory of all equipment assigned to officers and/or vehicles. All necessary data to complete PMT reports will be available to our agency for reporting purposes.
