Miscellaneous Information (Message Boards, shoulder width, detour roads, other improvements, etc.):
Jefferson County Public Works will be closing Old Lemay Ferry Road starting Tuesday, May 27th. This closure will allow their contractor, Above and Below Contracting, to complete the work on the sharp curve north of Frisco Hill and East Four Ridge Roads while not under traffic. This section of Old Lemay Ferry Road will reopen to at least one lane of two-way traffic on August 19th.

What part of Old Lemay Ferry Road is Closing?

- Old Lemay Ferry Road will be closed to traffic from the intersection of Frisco Hill and East Four Ridge Roads to approximately 5650 Old Lemay Ferry Road – approximately 1,565 feet.
- The road will remain open to the north of this closure. All residents will have access from the roundabout to this address.

When is Old Lemay Ferry Road Closing?

- Old Lemay Ferry Road will be closed starting Tuesday, May 27th, 2025 and reopened to traffic by Tuesday, August 19th, 2025.

Why is Old Lemay Ferry Road Closing?

#1 – Traffic Safety

- Currently Old Lemay Ferry Road has one-lane traffic through the work zone. Many motorists are bypassing the barricades and running regular speed through the work zone.

#2 – Fill Area Concerns

- The sharp curve north of Frisco Hill Road is one of the primary focuses of this project. As the roadway will need to be shifted, there is a large amount of fill that will need to be placed along the inside of this curve. Due to the existing topography, it will take significant effort to construct this fill slope, and with the amount of traffic still traveling through the work zone it is extremely difficult to do this and keep both workers and the public safe. The closure will allow the contractor to work on this slope without the concern of traffic.

Why choose May 27th – August 19th?

- These dates were focused on the Fox C-6 School Calendar. May 23rd, 2025 is Fox C-6's last day of school. With Memorial Day falling on Monday the 26th Jefferson County elected to start the closure on Tuesday May 27th.
- Fox C6 school district has the first day of school on August 20th. The Contractor has agreed to open this portion of Old Lemay Ferry Road to one lane of traffic by August 19th before school starts.
