**Miscellaneous Information** (Message Boards, shoulder width, detour roads, other improvements, etc.):  
Jefferson County Public Works will be closing Old Lemay Ferry Road south of Frisco Hill Road starting Tuesday, May 27th. The south closure will be for two weeks to allow the contractor to do some exploratory work for the proposed retaining wall, as well as complete some of the culvert replacements and related work on this section of the project. This section of Old Lemay Ferry Road will reopen to at least one lane of two-way traffic on June 9th. See Page 2 for additional details.

**What part of Old Lemay Ferry Road is Closing?**

- Old Lemay Ferry Road will be closed to traffic from approximately 5814 Old Lemay Ferry Road to the intersection of Frisco Hill and East Four Ridge Roads – approximately 605 feet.
- The road will remain open to the south of this closure for local residents. All residents will have access from the south (Dry Fork/Kneff) to the closure, but no access will be available to Frisco Hill or East Four Ridge.

**When is Old Lemay Ferry Road Closing?**

- Old Lemay Ferry Road will be closed starting Tuesday, May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2025 and reopened to traffic by Monday, June 9<sup>th</sup>, 2025.

**Why is Old Lemay Ferry Road Closing?**

**#1 – Traffic Safety**

- Currently Old Lemay Ferry Road has one-lane traffic through the work zone. Many motorists are bypassing the barricades and running regular speed through the work zone.

**#2 – Retaining Wall Construction**

- The Contractor has encountered more rock than originally anticipated during construction activities for the retaining wall. By closing this section of the road, the Contractor will be able to do some exploratory work to see what options are available with the wall construction, including different construction options. With the amount of traffic still traveling through the work zone it is extremely difficult to do this and keep both workers and the public safe. The closure will allow the contractor to work on this without the concern of traffic.

**#3 – Culvert Installation**

- There are some new culverts and rock lining that need to be installed in this section. A road closure will allow this work to proceed with increased worker safety.

**Why choose May 27<sup>th</sup> – June 9<sup>th</sup>?**

- This closure will coincide with the previously announced closure north of Frisco Hill and East Four Ridge. These dates were focused on the Fox C-6 School Calendar. May 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2025 is Fox C-6's last day of school. With Memorial Day falling on Monday the 26<sup>th</sup> Jefferson County elected to start the closure on Tuesday May 27<sup>th</sup>.
- The Contractor will have this south portion reopened to one lane of traffic and continue with the active work zone on Monday, June 9<sup>th</sup>. Pending results of the exploratory work, another closure of this section could take place in coordination with the north portion. In any case, the Contractor has agreed to open this portion of Old Lemay Ferry Road to one lane of traffic by August 19<sup>th</sup> before school starts.
