



The Jefferson County Sheriff's Office is requesting Proposals for Cellular Telephones with or without the option of unlimited Direct Connect or Push to Talk type options.

Verizon Wireless has proposed two (2) service plans to meet the requirements:

- 300 Anytime Minute Voice plan with Share Option for \$29.99
- 300 Anytime Minute Voice plan with Share Option and Push to Talk for \$34.99

The Communication Devices and Services must meet the following specifications.

1. 62 to 65 telephones with the option of additional phones within the package

Verizon Wireless has proposed the Motorola Barrage for the device as an option for the Jefferson County Missouri Sheriff's Office.

2. Equipment rotation or replacement plan

A wireless device must be in service for a minimum of 10 months to be eligible for an equipment upgrade at the discounted pricing regardless of contract vehicle chosen. If you choose to upgrade or replace equipment due to loss or theft of your device prior to completing 10 months of service, you may be charged full retail price.

10. Pooled minute plan

Share Options - America's Choice for Government with Share Option:




