The Notice of said hearing date shall be electronically filed in PDF format. To validate this automatic stay, the Motion Hearing date shall be applied for and obtained from the Court within five (5) days after filing of the Motion to Compel. The automatic stay shall then be effective until the Motion to Compel is heard. – LCR 33.5(2)

The Court has reviewed the Motion to Compel and, finding that the Motion and attached Golden Rule letter comply with LCR 32.6, grants said motion and orders that the obligations be complied with within 10 days of this order. If this order is not complied with, the moving party may request a hearing date for the other party to show cause why a \$500 sanction is not appropriate. SO ORDERED.
