SCHOOL DISTRICT OF THE CITY OF DE SOTO (DE SOTO #73)

(4/7ths Majority)

PROPOSITION STUDENTS FIRST

Shall the School District of the City of De Soto, Jefferson County, Missouri Board of Education borrow money in the amount of Eleven Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$11, 500, 000), resulting in no estimated increase to the debt service property tax levy, for the purpose of providing funds for the construction, equipping and furnishing of a gymnasium and classrooms at the Athena Elementary, additional classrooms and the installation of heating, ventilation, and air conditioning in the gymnasium at Vineland Elementary; to renovate the junior high library; to acquire certain facilities under lease in order to increase funds available for operating needs; and to the extent funds are available construction, equipping, and furnishing of additional cafeteria space for the Amvets campus; to convert the high school cafeteria into classrooms and renovate the junior high cafeteria; to complete other remodeling and repair improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and issue bonds, a portion of which may include Qualified School Construction Bonds and Qualified Zone Academy Bonds in an amount not to exceed the allocation from the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, for the payment thereof? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.6365 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.

HILLSBORO R-III SCHOOL DISTRICT

(4/7ths Majority)

PROPOSITION S.O.A.R.

Shall the Board of Education of the Hillsboro R-III School District of Jefferson County, Missouri, without an estimated increase in the current debt service property tax levy, borrow money in the amount of Eighteen Million Dollars (\$18,000,000) for the purpose of providing funds to complete repair, remodeling, space re-allocation, and renovation improvements to the Intermediate School; the completion of other remodeling and repair improvements to the existing facilities of the District; to complete the acquisition of facilities currently under lease to increase funds available for operating needs; and issue bonds, a portion of which may include Qualified School Construction Bonds to be issued under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Stimulus Act) in an amount not to exceed the allocation from the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, for the payment thereof? If this proposition is approved, the adjusted debt service levy of the School District is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.9493 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
