1           **AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO**  
2           **AWARD THE ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT AND TO EXECUTE**  
3           **THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN JEFFERSON COUNTY, MISSOURI AND HDR**  
4           **ENGINEERING, INC. FOR THE SECKMAN ROAD ROUNDABOUT AND**  
5           **PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS-PHASE 1 PROJECT DESIGNATED AS**  
6           **PROJECT STP-7202 (602) IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 4.**

7           **WHEREAS**, Jefferson, Missouri issued a Request for Qualifications for design,  
8           right of way, construction and construction engineering services for the Seckman Road  
9           Roundabout and Pedestrian Improvements-Phase 1 Project designated as project STP-  
10          7202 (602); and

11          **WHEREAS**, Jefferson, Missouri in response to a certain Request for  
12          Qualifications issued by the County, received proposals for design, right-of-way,  
13          construction and construction engineering services for the Seckman Road Roundabout  
14          and Pedestrian Improvements-Phase 1 Project designated as project STP-7202 (602); and

15          **WHEREAS**, after reviewing the proposals, the County selected three qualified  
16          engineering firms to interview for the Seckman Road Roundabout and Pedestrian  
17          Improvements-Phase 1 Project. Those firms were CDG Engineers, Inc., ABNA  
18          Engineering, Inc. and HDR Engineering, Inc.; and

1           **WHEREAS**, after interviewing the three qualified engineering firms, Jefferson  
2   County, Missouri has determined that a certain engineering firm, HDR Engineering, Inc.,  
3   represents the best qualified proposal for the project and meets the Request for  
4   Qualifications by Jefferson County; and

5           **WHEREAS**, Jefferson County, Missouri finds it now necessary and in the best  
6   interest of the County to award the Seckman Road Roundabout and Pedestrian  
7   Improvements-Phase 1 Project to HDR Engineering, Inc. as the best qualified firm and to  
8   execute an agreement for the design, right-of-way, construction and construction  
9   engineering services contract not to exceed one hundred fifty-one thousand seven  
10   hundred seventy-one dollars and eighteen cents (**\$151,771.18**), conditional on the  
11   concurrence of the Missouri Department of Transportation and the Federal Highway  
12   Administration. A copy of said agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

13           **BE IT ENACTED BY THE JEFFERSON COUNTY, MISSOURI,**  
14   **COUNCIL, AS FOLLOWS:**

15           Section 1. Jefferson County, Missouri awards the design, right of way,  
16   construction and construction engineering services contract for the Seckman Road  
17   Roundabout and Pedestrian Improvements-Phase 1 Project to the best qualified firm for  
18   the project, being HDR Engineering, Inc. in the amount of one hundred fifty-one  
19   thousand seven hundred seventy-one dollars and eighteen cents (**\$151,771.18**), subject to  
20   budgetary limitations.

21           Section 2. The County Council authorizes the County Executive to execute any  
22   agreement or document necessary to effectuate the award of the contract set forth in the

1      Ordinance. A copy of said agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated by  
2      reference.

3            Section 3. Copies of all Request for Qualifications, responses thereto, any contract  
4      agreements and change orders shall be maintained by the Department of the County  
5      Clerk consistent with the rules and procedures for the maintenance and retention of  
6      records as promulgated by the Secretary of State.

7            Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date  
8      of approval. If any part of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall  
9      not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.


