AND AUTHORIZATION FOR THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO EXECUTE ANY
NECESSARY AGREEMENTS OR CONTRACTS TO EFFECTUATE THE
AWARD OF THE BID FOR A PROJECT IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 6.**

WHEREAS, after reviewing the bids set forth above, the County has determined that a certain bid represents the lowest responsive bid for the respective project and meets the bid proposal specifications issued by the County; and

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WHEREAS, the Jefferson County, Missouri, Department of Public Works finds it is in the best interest of the County to award the bid to Brockmiller Construction, Inc. upon approval by the County Council and the County Executive for an amount not to exceed \$835,474.00 subject to budgetary appropriations. **BE IT ENACTED BY THE JEFFERSON COUNTY, MISSOURI,
COUNCIL, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The County awards the following bid which is incorporated by this reference as if fully set out herein, to the lowest responsive bidder for the project as follows:

AMOUNT

Up to \$835,474.00 subject to budgetary appropriations

AWARDED BIDDER

Brockmiller Construction, Inc.

Section 2. The Jefferson County, Missouri, Council hereby authorizes the County Executive to execute any agreements or contracts necessary to effectuate the award of the bid set forth in this Ordinance. A copy of said agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

1 The County Executive is further authorized to take any and all actions necessary to carry
2 out the intent of this Ordinance.

3 Section 3. Copies of the Invitation for Bid, responses thereto, and any contract
4 agreements shall be maintained by the Department of the County Clerk consistent with
5 the rules and procedures for the maintenance and retention of records as promulgated by
6 the Secretary of State.

7 Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date
8 of approval. If any part of this Ordinance is invalid for any reason, such invalidity shall
9 not affect the remainder of this Ordinance.
