1 **WHEREAS**, after reviewing the bids and proposals set forth above, the
2 Department of Public Works Division of Facility Services has determined that certain bids
3 and proposals represent the lowest and best bid for the respective items or services and met
4 the bid or proposal specifications issued by the County; and

5 **WHEREAS**, the Jefferson County, Missouri, Council finds it is in the best interest
6 of the County to award the bids and proposals to Integrity Septic and Sewer for a term from

8 award of the bids and proposals set forth in this Ordinance. The County Executive is
9 further authorized to take any and all actions necessary to carry out the intent of this
10 Ordinance.

11 **Section 3.** Copies of all Invitations for Bid, Requests for Proposals, responses
12 thereto, and any contracts or agreements shall be maintained by the Department of the
13 County Clerk consistent with the rules and procedures for the maintenance and retention
14 of records as promulgated by the Secretary of State.


15 **Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its


