



## Utility Permit Requirements

Any person/Company wanting to install a utility pipe, casing, cable or wire across, or under, a County maintained road within the County right of way, must have a permit.

The cost of the permit is \$50.00. A permit will **NOT** be issued until payment is received.

A \$5,000 performance bond is required **BEFORE** a permit can be issued. The bond made out to Jefferson County Highway Division, through applicants Insurance Company.

A Traffic Control plan must be presented for approval before any lane restrictions take place.

When applying for a Utility Permit, the applicant consents to the following actions being taken by the County:

- Inspection of the site for adherence to the requirements and standards as set by Chapter 700 of the UDO.
- Inspection of all work in progress for the project along a County Road; and
- Thereafter completion of the project to meet the satisfaction of the County.
